#### 6. Finance – N. Ciraldo

- Adoptions
  - Cat Adoptions are down ~52% from Q1
  - Dog Adoptions are up ~103% from Q1
- Donations
  - General Donations are down ~61% from Q1
  - Fund Raisers and memorials are both up slightly
- Total Revenue
  - Clinic Services have dropped ~3% from Q1
  - While revenue from Direct Donations has fallen ~46% from Q1
  - Net Loss for the clinic of ~2% compared to Q1
  - Net Loss for the shelter of ~53k or down ~672% from Q1
- Total Expenditures are down for the clinic and shelter from Q1
- **Bottom Line:** The primary reason for the net loss this quarter compared to the previous is driven by the decrease in Cat Adoptions and General Donations

# 7. Investment – R. Casey, N. Ciraldo

- Market volatility continues across financial markets:
  - Equity markets are down more than 20% YTD.
  - Bond performance has also been negative with higher interest rates and credit spreads (both negatively impacting bond performance).
- Markets continue to be concerned about elevated inflation and the effectiveness of the Federal Reserve bank to respond. Recession fears continue to rise.
- Cash target: Based on analysis of our financial statements, analyzed a conservative cash target. Will also explore opportunities on cash.
- Quarterly meeting with financial advisor in late July.

# 8. Clinic & Shelter Report – A. Zawrotny

- Clinic:
  - 295 successful surgeries, 60 POA animals in June
  - Decrease in revenue for the beginning of July was due to annual vacation for all staff scheduled 7/2-7/10.
  - Discussion on burnout and training challenges. Focusing efforts on in-depth training rather than pushing numbers.
  - All staff have completed the online RECOVER training. The in-person training will be scheduled in September or October.
- Shelter:
  - Met with Deb, Wethersfield ACO. Discussed a couple ideas on improving the Wethersfield kennels.
  - Exploration of ShelterLuv continues.

  - Spring Appeal: Funds raised as of 7/12 \$22,402
