### **Minutes**

- 2. Business Update J. Breen

- 4. Fundraising J. Sokol
  - Event successes:
    - Saturday, May 28: Annual Kitten Shower, Priam Vineyards in Colchester
      - ~\$2,683 from cash donations/raffles/NFG page
      - ~\$3,500 and counting in items donated
      - \$300 from the vineyard's bottle sales (10% of each bottle)
    - Sunday, June 19: Yoga with Cats, Afterglow Yoga in Hartford
  - Upcoming events:
    - Saturday, July 23: Paws in the Park tabling event, 10am 7pm at John Mitchell Fairgrounds in South Windsor
    - **Sunday, Aug. 21: Volunteer Appreciation Picnic**, 10:30am 5pm at Nevers Park Pavilion in South Windsor
    - **Sunday, August 28:** Dream Ride, 9am 4pm at Farmington Polo Club
  - Earmarking February/March 2023 for a return of the "big fundraiser"; committee will start talking more in late summer

#### 5. Social Media – A. Kim

- Discuss: Need more Board involvement with social media.
- We do not have a LinkedIn, but we will set one up. Explore Link Tree.
- Facebook algorithm works well with shares, comments, and loves, especially if it's within the first hour of posting.
- Include statistics in POA's newsletter and highlight tips. POA has reached 92k people in the past 28 days!!!!

## 6. Finance – N. Ciraldo

- Revenue (Gross Profit) is currently down ~29.5% from the PY
  - Primarily driven by our Direct Donations being down ~47.5% overall from the PY
  - Clinic Services are still performing strong at ~44.7% increase from the PY
- Total Expenses are up ~1% from the PY
- YTD, net loss of ~39k down ~134% from the PY with total Cash Flow down ~44k due to ~14k AP line item. We currently have ~855k in Free Cash Flow

## 7. Investment – R. Casey

- Market volatility continues across financial markets:
  - Equity markets are down more than 20% YTD.
  - Bond performance has also been negative with higher interest rates and credit spreads (both negatively impacting bond performance).
- Markets continue to be concerned about elevated inflation and the effectiveness of the Federal Reserve bank to respond. Recession fears continue to rise.

# 8. Clinic & Shelter Report – A. Zawrotny

- Clinic:
  - 306 successful surgeries in May, 24 POA animals.
  - Dr. Nicole Kovacs has joined us as a per diem vet (2-4 days/month)
  - Dr. Michelle Forella will be joining us as per diem vet (consistent weekly days starting in August).
  - Dr. Stockwell set up team for RECOVER training. The online course will be due by 7/11. We'll then plan for the physical training.
  - Discuss: Consider expanding from 4 to 5 days/week for surgeries. We have a lot of surgeons! Takeaway: Monthly clinic financial reporting in Quickbooks.

## Shelter:

- Discontinued Shelterbuddy and will receive a full refund.
- Several attempts to meet with Wethersfield Animal Control Officer to discuss Wetherfield shelter. Final attempt is 6/22 @ 9am.
- Investigating potential rental of the Portland, CT pound
- Cat Leadership team spoke about ways to increase intake and adoption
- **Discuss:** Schedule challenges with four locations and one clinic/shelter manager. Also need to improve communication challenges across POA.
- Discuss: ShelterLuv is being explored with a free trial. Does not have a volunteer database.



- 9. Program Coordinator Report K. Rossitto
  - Handbook committee has been formed to update volunteer handbooks. There will be an overall POA organization handbook and separate individual location handbooks, as well.
  - Donor Management
    - Spring Appeal: Funds raised as of 6/13 \$17,497
    - Birdies for Charity: Ending June 26<sup>th</sup>. Funds raised as of 6/13 \$6,936
  - United Spay Alliance: Quarterly meeting was 6/14.
  - Plan to e-mail clinic clients as a follow-up. Will be a small fee.
