- 4. Fundraising J. Sokol
  - Recent events
    - Saturday, October 1: K of C Picnic Received \$1,637; took their volunteers on a
      quick tour of POA, and they would like to continue supporting us in the future
    - Sunday, October 2: Cat Yoga sold out success (again!) Number TBD
    - Saturday, October 8: Fall in Love with POA Number TBD
    - Saturday, October 15: Peoples Choice Concurs Car Show Received 218 lbs of litter, 231 cans/cups of wet food, 75 bags/677 lbs of dry food, 24 bags/boxes of treats, plus toys and \$100
    - Friday, October 21: Strutting For Strays \$3,995 raised from baskets and donations; \$2,850 raised from ticket sales; \$12,190 in ticket sales, baskets and donations, and in-kind donations

- 5. Social Media A. Kim
  - Social media assistance: Looking for someone to assume lead role or serve as a co-lead
- 6. Finance N. Ciraldo
  - Revenue (Gross Profit) for October is currently up 90% from the Prior Month of September. Net profit is also positive for the first time this year, up 281% from the prior month of September, representing a total increase of ~40k to our cash flows:
    - This positive impact was primarily driven to a large Bequest of ~49k, our general donation of ~17.5k as well as Fund Raising which also generated ~5.1k in Revenue.
      - Cat Adoptions are down 34%
      - Dog Adoptions are up 66%
      - General Donations are up 404%
      - Fund Raisers are up ~548%
    - Clinic Services fell from the prior month by 27%
  - Total Expenses are down ~6% from the Prior Month
- 7. Investment –J. Bryne, R. Casey
  - Quarterly meeting with financial advisor to review investment portfolio performance.
  - Discuss: Investment options for cash
  - Please note: R. Casey has a conflict of interest and will recuse herself from any discussions about specific investment recommendations.
- 8. Clinic & Shelter Report A. Zawrotny
  - Clinic
    - 221 surgeries completed in October (14 days open), 45 POA animals
    - We are shooting for 16-17 surgeries per day with a 5 dog ratio currently.
  - Shelter
    - Planned ShelterLuv transfer by end of November / December 1<sup>st</sup>.
    - Dog prices have been adjusted and announced to both dog teams.
    - Consistent with broader theme across many shelters, 2022 will be the lowest year for adoptions since 2014 when we started tracking digitally.
